#### I. General Information

Welcome to the IOSCO General Secretariat! This handbook provides logistical information that we hope you find it useful for your visit. #### II. Health Protocol

No restrictions are applied to travellers wishing to visit Madrid, however mask are mandatory in public transportation, chemist, medical centres and elderly homes. A responsible use of the mask is also recommended in closed spaces of public use in which people transit or spend a long time. Likewise, the responsible use of the mask in crowded events is recommended for all people with a greater vulnerability to COVID-19 infection to maintain the use of a mask in any situation in which there is prolonged contact with people at a distance of less than 1.5 meters.

# III. Visa requirements for entering Spain

Information on visa requirements for entering Spain can be found on the official website of the Department of Foreign Affairs (link). As the time needed for a visa request varies from case to case, visitors are strongly recommended to take the necessary steps well in advance (at least 15 days before the intended visit), so that the visa can be issued in the required time. Applications are generally processed within 10–15 days. When completing the registration form for the meeting, please let the IOSCO General Secretariat know that you require a visa support letter.

#### IV. Hotel accommodation

IOSCO suggests the following hotels (listed in the ANNEX 1) with which agreements and partnerships have been brokered. You can book your hotel room through the "**Hotels and Practical Information**" document provided in the registration form. Unless otherwise agreed, you are responsible for settling your hotel bill. All hotels accept major credit cards.



# V. IOSCO General Secretariat from Barajas Airport

#### By taxi:

Taxis can be hailed outside the arrivals section of the Airport.

The journey into Madrid city centre takes approximately 20 minutes and prices range from approx. €30 - €40.

#### By Airport Express bus (the yellow one):

An express bus runs every day from terminals T1, T2 and T4 of Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas airport to the Atocha transport hub or to the Cibeles Metro station.

Frequency in normal traffic conditions is every 15-20 min from. 6:00am to 11:30pm and every 35 min. from 11:30pm to 06:00am.



The flat rate fare is 5€ (you can pay for the journey unectry to your bus unverin cash or via credit card).

# By Metro Line 8:

The metro line 8 "Nuevos Ministerios - Aeropuerto T4" connects the terminals to Madrid city from 06.05 a.m. to 01.30 a.m.

From Nuevos Ministerios you may walk to our offices (20 minutes), or change to metro line 6 to Republica Argentina (1 stop) which is a 5 minutes-walk from us.

The journey lasts around 15-20 minutes.

Price of a one way journey + the airport surcharge is aprox. €5.

# VI. Meeting Registration

The IOSCO General Secretariat uses an online registration for meeting participants to register. Only registered participants will be allowed into the IOSCO building and can attend meetings for which they are registered. Registrations are made through the IOSCO Members Area.

# VII. Entering IOSCO premises – Security badges

When you arrive at the main entrance of the IOSCO building, you will be issued a security badge, which provides access for the duration of your meeting. You will need to show your passport or national photo identity card as proof of identity.

At the end of the event, the badge should be returned to the security guard before you have exited the IOSCO building.
