IOSCO response to the conflict in the Ukraine

The IOSCO General Secretariat wishes to confirm to all IOSCO members and external stakeholders that i) in the immediate aftermath of the conflict in Ukraine, arrangements were put in place so that the Central Bank of Russia (ordinary member), the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Belarus (associate member) and the Russian National Association of Securities Market Participants (affiliate member) would not be able to participate in any respect in any IOSCO processes or fora until further notice, and ii) On 2nd May 2022 the IOSCO Board resolved that any future proposal for a resumption of active membership by one or more of these members could only come into effect after being discussed at a meeting of the IOSCO Board and following a formal Board decision.
